

## **Clubhouse and Activities FAQs**

### **Q. Do I have to pay the expected donation at Happy Hour, even if I don't eat or drink anything?**

A. This amount is asked of all who attend, since the funds we get from this admission fee are used for every-day clubhouse supplies, such as paper products and cleaning supplies and items like scotch tape, batteries, pens and paper.

### **Q. Do I have to bring food to share at Happy Hour?**

A. No. You are welcome to bring your own food or refrain from eating altogether. We like our Happy Hours to be "As you like it."

### **Q. Is there always a 50/50 raffle at Happy Hour? What do you do with the Committee's 50% share?**

A. Yes, this raffle is held at every HH and at some other events as well. Participation is totally optional. The Activities Committee's share of the funds is used for additional items like seasonal tablecloths and decorations, for prizes for occasional contests and/or games and to supplement extra expenses incurred for catering and/or entertainment.

### **Q. Must our group - a committee or club - reserve the clubhouse for meetings or get-togethers?**

A. Since our clubhouse has only one meeting room, you are advised to do this, so that two different groups are not planning to meet at the same time. Scheduling is done through a clubhouse chair – or another designated person. Currently, that person is Cheryl Werner.

### **Q. Can I use the clubhouse for a family event or private party?**

A. No. The community voted on this issue, and it was made policy in 2019. If any resident seeks to change the policy, he/she would need to go through the Board for another community vote.

### **Q. What is the difference between the Clubhouse Committee and the Activities Committee?**

A. The Clubhouse Committee consists of volunteers in positions responsible for the building itself: Committee Co-chairs, Treasurer, Librarian and Building Maintenance. The Activities Committee is a subcommittee, responsible for planning and carrying out social events and community outreach.

**Q. Do I have to pay for beverages when I'm in the clubhouse?**

A. If you are at a meeting of a VOLC committee, the answer is No. If you are meeting with a social group or are there on your own, we request a donation be placed in the can found on the counter.

**Q. Is there Wi-Fi in the clubhouse? How do I access it?**

A. Yes. The "myvolc" network should show in your settings. The PW is "volc19702".

**Q. Does the TV work in the clubhouse and can I use it?**

A. Yes. Directions are on the mantel above the fireplace. A universal remote controls all functions. The business account doesn't include premium channels.

**Q. Can I adjust the temperature settings?**

A. Yes, but please restore them to the setting you found when you entered.

**Q. Is there a checkout system for library books?**

A. No. Take as many as you want and return them when you're finished.

**Q. If I find something broken or something breaks while I'm there, whom should I contact?**

A. One of the Committee Co-chairs – Maria Tricarico or Cheryl Werner.

**Q. Where can I get another key fob?**

A. Our management company, IPS, handles those requests.
